133. Abandoning vehicle in a public place causing inconvenience to others or passengers can result in suspension/cancellation of driving license.

135. Abandoning a transport vehicle as a mark of protest or agitation or any kind of strike in a public place or in any other place in a manner causing obstruction or inconvenience to the public or passengers or other users of such places, the driving license is liable to be suspended/cancelled.

137. Carrying overload in goods carriages can attract suspension/cancellation of driving licence.

139. The driver of a taxi refusing the offer for journey for the reason that the distance is short can attract suspension/cancellation of driving licence.

141. When you reach an intersection where there is no signal light or police man, you will, give way to the traffic approaching the intersection on your right side and proceed after giving necessary signals.

143. While you are approaching an intersection where the yellow signal light is blinking, you should slow down the vehicle and proceed only after ensuring that it is safe to do so.

Parking lot – Autorikshaws

145. Where the road is marked with continuous yellow line the vehicle should not touch or cross the yellow line.

Intends to turn right.

147. While you are driving on gradient roads, you should give precedence to the vehicles going up the hill .

Intends to turn left.

149 The driver of a tractor shall not carry any person other than the driver.

150. The signal represents



Intends to slow down the vehicle.

151. While a vehicle entering a main road from a branch road the driver shall give preference to all vehicles proceeding along the main road.

Intends to stop the vehicle.

153. You can overtake a vehicle through the left side, if the driver of that vehicle indicates his intention to turn right and proceeds to the center of the road.

Request to stop the vehicle from behind.

155. "Tail-gating" is the driving too close behind a vehicle in a dangerous manner.

Request to stop the vehicle from behind and front.

157. A vehicle can be seized by authorized officers, if the vehicle is not covered by a valid registration or permit.

158. The signal represents



Request to stop the vehicle from front.

159. Electric horn is permitted.

160. On one-way road the driving in reverse gear is prohibited.

161. If drunken driving is detected, the driver is liable to be punished with imprisonment which may extent to 6 months or Rs.2000/- as fine or both.

162. You hold a learners licence for motor cycle then you will not carry any other person on the motor cycle except for the purpose of getting instructions from an instructor who holds a valid driving licence to drive motor cycle.

163. When the yellow light at an intersection appear on the signal light, the driver of a approaching vehicle should slow down to stop.

164. All motor vehicles must be covered by third party Insurance.

165. Safe distance according to speed is the minimum distance to be kept from the vehicle going in front.

166. The number of passengers permitted to be taken in private vehicle is recorded in the registration Certificate.

167. Overtaking is prohibited when vehicle is driven on a steep hill.

168. If the road is marked with broken white lines, you can change track if required.

169. Blinking red traffic light means stop the vehicle and proceed if safe.

170. Maximum permitted speed of a motor car on national high way in the state is 70 km/hour.

171. Driving cautiously anticipating violation of traffic rules and road signs both by drivers and other road users is “Defensive Driving”.

172. A line with 5 centimeters width in white or yellow colour at the approach of road junction or pedestrian crossing is stop line.

173. Before starting the engine of a vehicle you should check radiator water level and engine oil level.

174. Maximum permissible speed of a motor cycle is 50 Km/hr.

175. Motor Car is the only vehicle which is permitted to be driven at a speed exceeding 60 Km/hr.

176. Maximum permissible speed of a motor car near educational institution is 25 km/hour

177. Maximum permitted speed of trucks on national high way in the state is 60 km/hour.

178. Maximum permissible speed of a two wheeler near educational institution is 25 km/hour.

179. Projection of load up to one meter (100 cms.) is allowed in goods carriages.

180. When lorries are loaded then the load shall not project on both sides.

181. Maximum length of load that can be projected from the rear part of a goods carriage is 100 cm.

182. Maximum permissible speed of heavy motor vehicles in the cities is 45 Km/hr.

183. Maximum distance allowed between towing and towed vehicles is 5 meters.

184. Maximum permissible speed of a motor cycle in cities is 40 km/hour

185. You are driving on a two-lane street vehicle in front of you is moving very slowly and the road ahead is clear for overtaking then you should pass the vehicle from the left hand side.

- 186. Maximum speed permitted for vehicles towing another vehicle is 24 km/hour.**
- 187. Motor vehicle which is not permitted to drive in ghat roads at a speed of more than 30 Km/h is motor car.**
- 188. Under no circumstances in which a motor cycle can be driven at the speed of 60 km/hour.**
- 189. The maximum speed permitted for motor cycles in city during night time is 30 Km/hr.**
- 190. Maximum permitted weight that can be carried on a goods carriage allowed as per permit.**
- 191. The minimum fine for over-loading in goods carriage is Rs- 2000/-**
- 192. Maximum permissible speed of an auto rickshaw near educational institution is 25 km/hour.**
- 193. Maximum permissible speed of a light motor vehicle near educational institution is 25 km/hour.**
- 194. Maximum permissible speed of motor car on ghat roads is 40 km/hour.**
- 195. Maximum permissible speed of motor cycle on ghat roads is 40 km/hour.**
- 196. Maximum permissible speed of an auto rickshaw is 40 Km/hr.**
- 197. Maximum permissible speed of a light motor vehicle is 60 Km/hr.**
- 198. Maximum permissible speed of a medium motor vehicle is 60 Km/hr.**
- 199. According to section 112 of the Motor Vehicles Act 1988 prescribes the maximum speed at which each class or type of motor vehicle can be driven**
- 200. Section 113 of the Motor Vehicle Act 1988 stipulates that the driver should not drive a vehicle exceeding the weight permitted to carry.**
- 201. Maximum speed allowed to vehicles passing a procession is 25KM/hr.**
- 202. The height limit of load on goods vehicle from ground level is 3.8 meters.**
- 203. Maximum permissible speed of heavy motor vehicle near education institution is 15 km/hour.**
- 204. Maximum permissible speed of a heavy passenger motor vehicle near educational institution is 15 km/hour.**

205. According to section 129 of Motor Vehicle Act 1988 a person driving a motor cycle shall wear helmet.

206. Maximum permissible speed of a medium motor vehicle near educational institution is 15 km/hour.

207. Maximum permissible speed of autorickshaws on ghat road is 30 km/hour.

208. Maximum permissible speed of heavy motor vehicles on ghat roads is 35 km/hour.

209. Maximum permissible speed of Autorikshaws in cites and municipal towns is 30 Km/hr.

210. Maximum permissible speed of heavy motor vehicles is 60 Km/hr.

211. Maximum permissible speed of medium motor vehicles on ghat roads is 35 km/hour.

212. You wish to take "U" turn at an intersection controlled by a traffic light you should make the "U" turn if there is a policeman at the intersection.
